# Transition at PAS

**S**top by 50 E. 87th Street, and you will notice a great deal of activity in addition to our robust programmatic and worship offerings. We are preparing to move to our temporary space at 4 E. 90th Street, located around the block behind our new Eli M. Black Lifelong Learning Center. There are cardboard boxes stacked in the offices and large trash and recycling bins in the hallways. We are sorting materials and cleaning out our offices, closets, and corridors – a once-in-a-generation housecleaning!

In late April, staff offices will relocate to our temporary space. Programs and worship, except for Shabbat and holiday services in the Sanctuary, will move to the Eli M. Black Lifelong Learning Center and our temporary space. (The PASECC will move to the temporary space after the academic year ends in late May.) While our space will be different, the clergy and staff, worship and programs will remain the same. We will begin our days with morning minyan and conclude them with educational programs, committee meetings, and music rehearsals.
