

PAS@87th Update

Construction at the our 87th Street building is progressing well. The photos show new construction on the roof, where the ECC playground and the congregational sukkah will be located; framing on the second floor, where staff offices will be located; and the creation of a dramatic glass-enclosed central stairwell. Last month, staff and board members began regular meetings to plan the move from our temporary space back to 87th Street, as well as to anticipate the logistics of programming in the new space. The May/June Bulletin will have another update about the transition, including information about locations for summer Shabbat worship.



The main stairwell will be enclosed in glass so that you see the floors of the building as you go up and down. The staircase currently reaches the third floor.



A two-story extension on the roof will provide space for a new playground for the ECC and a large space for a sukkah.



The second floor of the revitalized building will be devoted to office space for clergy, programming staff, and administrative staff.
