A New York Jew who was living in Atlanta, Leo Frank was falsely convicted of murder and lynched in 1915. This incident has affected the identity of Jews in the South since it occurred.

- 11:30 am Sunday morning services at Ebenezer Baptist Church, *Dr. King's church*

Explore a museum about the Civil Rights Movement.
