- Traditional services for Rosh Hashanah Day 1, Kol Nidrei, and Yom Kippur, which will be ticketed and held in the Sanctuary and Lower Level at 87th Street, and Fifth Avenue.
- Two different in-person family services for both elementary-age families and young families age 0–5.
- Creative and engaging drop-off programs for school-age children and teenagers.

We are excited to share new programs that include robust services to ensure that we reach all our members. Expect something for everyone! We are still in the planning stages, so check back often for **more details!**

YACHAD ("TOGETHER") SERVICE

On the second day of Rosh Hashanah, in addition to our traditional services, a new and innovative service, **Yachad ("Together")**, will be held. This service will join worshippers across generations in a warm and welcoming environment.

The full service, located on the Lower Level at 87th Street, will be geared toward those 12 and older and is open to all PAS members with High Holiday tickets. There will be open seating in the main sanctuary for those members with 87th Street tickets who prefer a traditional service. We will also continue to hold traditional services at Fifth Avenue.

20s AND 30s

On the first day of Rosh Hashanah, Kol Nidrei, and Yom Kippur, we will be hosting special services for those in their **20s and 30s** providing an opportunity to stream services in an intimate setting to catch up and reconnect with friends.

Attendance will be limited to those in their 20s and 30s who are children of members or hold their own High Holiday tickets. **Advance registration** will be required, so **check back for more details!**
