This BBYO trip is being planned in partnership with **Central Synagogue** for students from both communities who have completed 9th – 12th grades. We are working closely with BBYO to serve as our trip provider to help us design this custom travel experience.

First stop: Spain. We'll learn about the rich history of Jews in Spain, from the medieval times, to the Spanish Inquisition, to what it's like to be a Jewish teen in Spain today.

Second stop: Israel! Experience the northern Galilee region, the sunshine in the Negev desert, and the vibrant energy of urban Tel Aviv as you forge a personal connection with the Jewish homeland.

While we will visit the essential sites in Israel, this trip is being designed to go deeper and be more than a typical teen tour. Highlights will include:

- Israeli teens who will be part of the group for the entire experience
- Clergy from both synagogues will be joining the group
- The teens will engage in four meaningful community service opportunities
