- Visit the Salad Trail, a unique touch-and-taste farm in the northern Negev. The tour gives a hands-on display of agricultural high-tech, and a crash course in environmental techniques.
- Return to Tel Aviv.

DAY 5

LEND A HAND

Wed. Dec 25, 2024

- Check out of the hotel.
- Israeli agriculture is a strategic need and a powerful symbol of the Zionist story. Volunteer with Leket, an NGO focusing on providing food to Israel's weakest populations.
- Visit an IDF army base, including dialogue with soldiers and officers.
- Drive to Jerusalem.
- A First Look at the Holy City: Over the centuries, many have been moved and awed by their first sight of Jerusalem. We'll celebrate our arrival with a special ceremony and the traditional "Shehechianu" blessing of thanksgiving with a stunning view of the Old City walls.
- Check into the hotel and light Hanukkah candles.
- Join Professor Reuven Hazan of the Political Science Department at Hebrew University for an introduction into Israel's turbulent political scene (a separate activity for younger kids will be arranged at the same time).

DAY 6

KOL YISRAEL AREVIM ZEH BAZEH

Thu. Dec 26, 2024

- Enter the Old City of Jerusalem.
- Enjoy a Bnai Mitzvah ceremony at the stairs of the Huldah Gates, which once led into the Temple Mount.
- Tour the Jerusalem Archaeological Park, including the Davidson Center and Robinson's Arch.
- Tour Jerusalem's Old City and the Jewish Quarter.
- Free time for lunch and shopping at Hurva Square, the hub of the modern-day Jewish Quarter.
- A Thread of Love: Help disabled children celebrate their Bnai Mitzvah through a Tikkun Olam activity with the Masorti (Conservative) Movement in Israel. We'll learn how to tie tzitzit (tassles) which will be thread into the talitot (prayer shawls) worn by young Jews with disabilities as they are called to the Torah. We'll also hear about the Masorti movement's inspiring education and Jewish enrichment programs for the disabled and participate in an interactive workshop about living with limitations.
- We're dancing in the streets! Celebrate a new age for the Jewish people. Join Guru Zuzu – on a magical mystery tour of Jerusalem's Mamila Boulevard – a combination of story, music, and dance. Get into a party mood.
- Special Bnai Mitzvah celebration dinner and party and Hannukah candle lighting.

DAY 7

DIGGING FOR ROOTS

Fri. Dec 27, 2024

- Icebreakers with teens from NOAM, the Masorti youth movement, who will join you for the dig at Beit Guvrin.
- Take part in an interactive archeological dig geared to all ages at the Beit Guvrin Caves.
- Return to the hotel to prepare for Shabbat.
- Light Shabbat and Hanukkah candles.
- The City of Shabbat: Join Jerusalem in welcoming the Sabbath, the high point of the Jewish week, with Kabbalat Shabbat services.
- Shabbat dinner at the hotel.

DAY 8

SHABBAT IN JERUSALEM

Sat. Dec 28, 2024

- Optional: Shabbat morning services at a local Jerusalem synagogue.
- Lunch at the hotel.
- Optional: Afternoon walking tours:
 - The Old City Ramparts: Stroll along the ancient outer walls for a bird's-eye view of the remarkably diverse yet closely bound communities of Jerusalem's Old City.
 - A Mountain Holy to Many: Experience the complexity of inter-religious relations on Mount Zion. We'll first visit the Upper Room. It is venerated by Christians as the location of Jesus' Last Supper but was, for a period, converted into a mosque. In a room directly below, Jews pray at the place believed to be King David's Tomb.
- Mark the end of Shabbat with a communal Havdalah ceremony overlooking the Old City followed by Hanukkah candle lighting.
- Take an evening tour through the Jerusalem neighborhoods to experience the Festival of Lights.

DAY 9

THE DEAD SEA BASIN

Sun. Dec 29, 2024

- Climb via the Snake Path OR take the cable car to the top of Masada.
- Float on the Dead Sea and enjoy a buffet lunch at the hotel.
- Return to the hotel for Hanukkah candle lighting.



- Dialogue with journalist Haviv Rettig Gur, political correspondent and analyst for The Times of Israel (a separate activity for younger kids will be arranged at the same time).

LEAVING A MARK

Mon. Dec 30, 2024

- Adults and children over 10: Visit Yad Vashem. Your guided tour will include:
 - The Children's Memorial.

- Children's program: The Bloomfield Science Museum.
- Mount Herzl is Israel's central military cemetery and hosts the graves of the leaders of the nation. Visit Mount Herzl and contend with the human price paid by Israeli families and the country in the Israel-Hamas War.
- Experience the sights, smells, and tastes of Jerusalem while walking through the Mahane Yehuda open-air market.
- Visit Pantry Packers, where you will pack food for Israel's poorest families.
- Late check out.
- Farewell dinner.
- Transfer to Ben-Gurion International Airport for your flight back to the US.
